Possession and consumption of recreational marijuana was legal in Nevada starting on January 1, 2017.

H2: By state law, Washoe County is permitted to collect a fee of 3% of gross revenue annually collected from a marijuana establishment's business licensing to cover costs of marijuana regulation in unincorporated Washoe County.

H2: It is illegal to drive under the influence of marijuana. The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has conducted training to identify drivers impaired by marijuana. Driving under the influence is punishable by the same felony DUI as driving under the influence of alcohol.

Marijuana establishments can open in any location of their choosing in unincorporated Washoe County if it's commercially or industrial-zoned, is 300 feet from a community location, and 1,000 feet from a school. Since these establishments are treated as any other business, the community cannot influence the location of these establishments.
